Chief Wallace and 2<sup>nd</sup> Chief Ross 11 12 were also in attendance. 13 **REDW AUDIT PRESENTATION** 14 REDW representative, Wes Daniels, is here to present the audit report 15 of the Governmental Services Department for the year ended 16 17 September 30, 2017. The Audit Wrap-Up Report, Basic Financial 18 Statements, Independent Auditor's Reports, and Single Audit 19 Reporting Package were reviewed and discussed. - 61 Spiva Art Center: A Native American Contemporary Exhibit opened
- at the Spiva Art Center and will run through the first week of March.
- Indigo Sky Casino is a sponsor of this event and provided
- 64 refreshments that were very well received. It was the largest grand
- opening Spiva has had and they contributed this plaque to the casino
- 66 in honor of that.
- 67 **Michigan Trip:** I will be going to Michigan next Thursday and Friday.
- 68 River Raisin National Battlefield Park is doing a film and they are
- interviewing the tribes that were there during the War of 1812.
- 70 **Serpent Mound Winter Solstice:** We have established a very close
- 71 relationship with the Ohio History Connection and I am so proud they
- have stepped up and said there will not be a winter solstice ceremony
- at the Serpent Mound as there are many things that go on during this
- 74 that are not appropriate.
- 75 Martin Luther King Day: Tribal Admin will be closed on this holiday
- but the Early Childhood Learning Center will be open.
- 77 **Audit Report:** As reported earlier we did very well with the audit.
- 78 The cost of the audit has dropped tremendously the past years due to
- 79 excellent department organization.
- 80 Tribal Admin Pay Rate Proposal: The proposal is simple: 2% cost
- of living for everyone; up to 2% merit increase for employees whose
- wages are under \$15 an hour; up to 1.5% merit increase for
- employees whose wages fall within \$15-20 per hour; and up to 1%
- merit increase for employees making over \$20 per hour. This proposal
- was discussed at the Director's Meeting last week and all were

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- 88 seemingly in favor of the approach. Furthermore, Karen has analyzed
- these proposed figures and they fall in line with what was 89
- 90 budgeted for salary increases for this fiscal year. Lengthy discussion 91 held.
- 92 **Turning the Spend:** This event will be held Thursday, January 18,
- 2018, at Indigo Sky Casino. This is a round table discussion for rapidly 93
- growing business in Indian Country with several tribes participating. 94
- 95 Breakfast begins at 7:30 a.m.
- 96 **Enrollment Information:** There are currently 3,429 enrolled and of
- 97 these 1,198 live in Oklahoma.
- Winter Gathering: The Winter Gathering will be held Saturday, 98
- 99 January 20, 2018 in the Annex. This begins at 5:00 p.m. and a meal
- 100 will be provided.
- State Line Road: There is a meeting scheduled for January 11<sup>th</sup> with 101
- the Miami BIA and the Muskogee BIA to discuss the State Line road. 102
- 103 **Donation:** As reported earlier we have run out of space at the
- 104 Children's Learning Center. I would like permission to write the
- 105 Shakopee Tribe to request a donation to increase the space at this
- 106 facility. Discussion held and all were in favor.
