- 56 held for all Oklahoma Tribes at the Gilcrease Museum. Chief indicated
- 57 she attended for the Eastern Shawnee Tribe as well as represented the
- 58 Inter-Tribal Council.
- 59 **Donation Request:** There were no donation requests above Chief's
- 60 \$250.00 limit.
- Bank Summary: Total shown at the end of January for Total Assets
- was \$199,075,000; Net Loans was \$153,000,000; Loan to deposit
- Ratio 87.61%; Total Deposits \$174,883,000; Eastern Shawnee
- Deposits \$64,000,000; Book Value per Share increased to \$1,337.82
- and Eastern Shawnee Value is \$9,382,000.
- 66 **Stateline Road** Approval was received for the contractor to begin
- using the borrow pit. This had been held up by a slow response from
- 68 some THPOs who had not responded to potential archeological
- 69 concerns in that area.
- 70 **Duplex Construction Report** The weather has been working
- against us, but the saferoom forms have been set and they are
- 32 supposed to pour tomorrow.
- 73 **Director and Travel Reports** Were provided to the Business
- 74 Committee for review.
- 75 Native American Impact Study The study was last completed in
- 76 2011. They are requesting participation of all Tribes this year to show
- 77 the true impact of Native American Tribes. The information will be
- 78 shared with the Oklahoma City University Center for Native American
- 79 and Urban Studies (OCU). OCU will compile the data and will not
- release any individual Tribe's information. Each Tribe will receive a
- report on their own information.
- Wellness Center Equipment Bids were received on the following
- Wellness Center equipment: (6) power fold basket ball goals, power
- 84 fold volleyball net, powered drop-down batting cage, and a powered
- 85 divider curtain to split the gym keeping it functional for members when
- only a portion is needed for an event. The best quote came in about

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- \$14,000 less than projected. The Requisition will be presented for approval this evening.
- 2019 Administration Salary Schedule The new salary schedule
- 90 (increases) were reviewed. The format has changed this year, but the
- 91 total projected expense falls within the budget.
- 92 **FY19 Tribal Administration Goals** Were provided to the Business
- 93 Committee for review.
- 94 Grant Submissions (4) Grant Submissions will be presented
- tonight. The staff who are or will be involved in the grants are here to
- 96 answer questions.
- 97 Land Purchase A map demonstrating how the McKibben Property,
- 98 recently approved for purchase, will connect multiple Tribal Properties
- 99 together.

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STRATEGIC PLAN - SKYLAR WALLACE

- 102 Skylar presented an update on the Strategic Plan. He briefly covered
- 103 how the Strategic Plan came to be and the primary goals of the Plan.
- 104 The Strategic Plan Committee needs to know if the Business
- 105 Committee would like reports on a quarterly basis, if they can
- designate a Chairman of the Committee, and how the committee
- members will be seated. The Strategic Plan Committee will attend the
- 108 Business Committee Working Session Meeting in March for further
- 109 discussion and direction.
