38	The Finance Director, Karen Allen, presented a detailed review on Cash
39	Balances, Non Grant Budgets and Grant Budgets for Tribal
40	Administration. She also provided Financial Statements of all entities
41	(Eastern Shawnee Tribal Enterprises, Eastern Shawnee Tribal
42	Administration, Indigo Sky Casino, Outpost Casino and Bordertown

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Center, N2N Solutions, N2N HR Solutions, N2N Staffing, N2N HR OK, N2N Logistics, N2N 3PL, N2N University and Burgraff) as of December 31,2017. Many questions were asked and lengthy discussion was held.

## **Compliance and EGM, Deputy Commissioner Amber Graham:**

- Internal Audit Report given for MICS/TICS and Title 31 for the last two quarters. Scheduled NIGC Training for Internal Audit is March 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> and more training is scheduled in June for Compliance Auditing.
- There are six (6) employees in the Compliance Department. The

- 84 20. There are three (3) employees in EGM Compliance. They
- 85 attended NIGC Technology Training January 30-31, 2018 and there

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 machines installed at Indigo Sky Casino in March. Michael Daugherty received Employee of the Quarter. There were 20 Installs; 20 Removals; 6 Conversions; 2 Replacements; 14 Machine Relocations; and 74 Pieces of software tested. Machine Fees billed amounted to \$72,350.00 and there was \$71,350.00 collected.

Licensing, Deputy Commissioner Ashley Burnside: This department has four (4) employees (50% ESTOO, 50% Other Native). There were 26 New Hires processed, 43 employee renewals processed, one (1) denial, one (1) suspension and one (1) revocation. There was one (1) gaming vendor processed, one (1) gaming related company processed, zero (0) gaming parent companies processed, and 29 gaming vendor and gaming related individuals processed. We processed 8 non-gaming companies and 41 non-gaming individuals. Fees: Total fees collected for February 2018: \$21,525.00. PRYME: This is completed for employees and we are using it for records and workflow. The online app is being customized and we continue to do orientation every week. Soon potential employees will fill out their application online and only come in to be finger printed. Once the last piece is in place we will move with utilizing PRYME for

**Resolution #022818R-04:** Authorizing the Eastern Shawnee Family Violence Prevention Program to submit a Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant available through the District Attorneys Council State of Oklahoma. **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Business Committee of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma does hereby wish to authorize the Eastern Shawnee Family Violence Prevention Program to submit a Victims of Crime Act Grant totaling \$59,600 (approx.) with zero tribal match required.
