- 50 ribbon cutting will be immediately followed by a Make A Wish
- Oklahoma Charity Shoot. The event is open to anybody who wishes to participate.
- 53 **Bank Summary:** For the first time in history the bank exceeded the
- \$200 million mark for total assets. The dividends were paid last
- month which typically means share value does not increase. However,

- absolutely factual and is the posting constructive or destructive. She
