33	RESCUE ACT 1.9 TRILLION – Announcement made by Chief
34	Wallace that this has passed. Has the largest amount that has
35	ever happened in the United States for the American Indians.
36	930 million goes to BIA, quite a bit of money goes to rental
37	assistance and some of that could go to Tribe's and there is
38	quite a bit of money set aside for Tribal Languages.
39	ORIGINAL CARE'S ACT STIMULUS PAYMENT – We voted to pay
40	\$1,000 to Adults and \$500.00 to children under the age of 18.
41	We have expended all of that money. Chief Wallace requested
42	that we put out a notice that those funds have been expended
43	and that we are not taking additional applications.

- We have extended these payments for 7 full months.
- 45 Authorization was given to Chief Wallace by the Business
- 46 Committee to put out the notice that these funds have been
- 47 expended and we are no longer taking applications.
- 48 AOA The sprinkler system malfunctioned and we had pipes to
- 49 burst so the AOA has been closed since Feb. 15th, 2021. The
- 50 AOA will be opening on Monday of this week. It is a drive thru
- pick-up and the hours are still the same 11-12:30. They are
- 52 serving out of the West door.
- 53 **BANK DIVIDEND \$245,455 has been paid.**
- 54 **BUDDY HARRIS REQUEST Rowdy Harris, his son, has a severe**
- 55 pituitary injury that he had to have surgery for that has left
- 56 him unable to do much. Rowdy has 4 dogs that he had been
- 57 releasing about 4 times a week down by the creek to let them
- run. He indicates that he was stopped by the Police, so he is
- 59 submitting a request that his son be able to do that as this is an
- outlet for his son. As this is on the POW WOW side this request
- will be given to the POW WOW Committee to make the
- 62 determination.
- 63 **DIRECTOR REPORTS Submitted and provided to each**
- 64 Business Committee Member.
- 65 EQUINE THERAPY LOCATION Chief Wallace states we have
- 66 received a grant and she would like to know the preference as
- to where to conduct Equine Therapy classes. Could be held on
- the ground that is south of the ECLC behind the police station,
- 69 the arena at the Recycling Center or Covered Arena at
- 70 Bordertown. Pros and cons of each were presented.
- 71 Discussion followed concerning the hiring of an Equine
- 72 Therapist, job description and requirements, possible
- 73 duplication of services. Treasurer Barrett requested that the
- 74 job description be amended to reflect what the Business
- 75 Committee approved when they authorized the grant the
- 76 person hired is to be a licensed Psychologist. This will be
- 77 discussed further at the Business Committee Planning Meeting
- 78 on March 24th at 10:00 A.M.
- 79 TREASURY PRESENTATION MARCH 18 SHAWNEES VS. YELLIN -

- 80 This was a conference that you could log into scheduled for
- 81 March 18th and today the title was changed to Shawnees vs
- 82 Yellin. Yellin is the appointee of Biden's to the Treasury. Chief
- 83 Wallace is registered to attend this conference to listen. Ben
- 84 Barnes believes that the Treasury will lose the lawsuit that the
- 85 Shawnees have filed in the first CARE's Act when their
- population was reported as zero and so they received only
- \$100,000 funding and the Shawnees filed suit to challenge
- 88 that. The first ruling went against the Shawnees, but they
- 89 appealed it. The second ruling went in favor of the Shawnees
- 90 that it was not a correct way to distribute the funds and they
- 91 would hopefully receive additional monies. The formula would
- 92 be changed. This is now in the final appeals and Ben believes
- 93 that the Treasury is going to lose. This Business Committee
- has discussed whether we should file a suit or not. Chief
- 95 Wallace has sent the information to Attorney Daniel Gomez so
- that he can decide if he wants to listen in to this conference.
- 97 NANCY WEEKS FUNERAL is at 11:00 on March 11th, 2021 in the
- 98 Sandy Captain Cultural Center.
- 99 RENTAL ASSISTANCE Chief Wallace reviewed very quickly.
- 100 We can receive almost \$87,000 for rental assistance to our
- 101 tribal members. We would spend however much the
- applications that come in. It is for only rental, not for people
- who own their homes. They can receive assistance for up to 3
- months if they have been in arears on their rent or if they are
- 105 having difficulty now it can also be used for utilities. It is a
- maximum of three months of up to \$2500. assistance. There
- will be an application for this and there will be requirements.
- 108 Information is in BC packets to be reviewed later tonight.
