





WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma, Article IX, Section 1(d), delegates the power to enter into any obligation or contract to the Business Committee; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Title 25 CFR Part 162.341(b), the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma may grant a lease acting through their appropriate officials; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 25 CFR Part 162.334, the Tribe will not require a lessee to provide a performance bond; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 25 CFR Part 162.335, the Tribe will not require a lessee to provide insurance for a residential lease document; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 25 CFR Part 162.241(c), at the discretion of the Tribe, administrative lease fees may be waived.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Glenna J. Wallace, Chief of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma, or her designee (as provided in writing), is authorized to conduct negotiations on behalf of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma and approve and execute any and all documents relating to the subject lease.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Business Committee of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma does hereby wish to approve the attached Residential Lease of property owned by the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma located at 10995 S. 679 Rd., Wyandotte, OK 74370, commonly known as the Stoner House for a period of one (1) year with lease number 921 000G040033 with BIA TAAMS Document Number 4200324536; does hereby waive all bonds associated with this lease; does hereby waive insurance requirements; and does hereby expressly waive administrative fees associated with this transaction.

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma is committed to protecting and preserving the interests of the tribal membership; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma is committed to the concept of Indian Tribes functioning as sovereign governments; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Business Committee of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma does hereby approve the Dual Enrollment Policy for Tribal Benefits for all claims and benefits which shall include but is not limited to Health and Social Services, Education, and Specialized Services. Indian Child Welfare, CCDF, and HAVEN are specifically excluded from this resolution. This policy shall also be posted in the Health and Social Services Manual.

It has long been the policy of the Eastern Shawnee tribe that persons who meets the membership requirements of more than one tribe may be a member of both tribes provided that the constitution, resolution, ordinance, or membership policy does not expressly exclude enrolling persons who are members of another tribe. Persons who possess these qualifications that allow them to meet the membership requirements in more than one tribe may share in the benefits of only one of them.


Fraudulent Sanctions Policy for Tribal Benefits

The Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma is a federally recognized Indian tribe; therefore theft of funds from the tribe is a criminal offense, which is punishable by law. This policy was created in order to protect the trust tribal members have placed in the staff of the Eastern Shawnee tribal office and conduct the (insert department) programs with integrity. This will ensure that funds continue to be available to all the tribal members who have needs and qualify for (insert department) benefits. The following actions will occur with any fraudulent claims submitted

- ATTEMPTED FRAUD Warning with denial of claim package that contained fraudulent material. Multiple attempts shall result in the review of suspension of services
- PROVED FRAUD One (1) year household suspension from ALL tribal programs, with suspension permanent until repayment of all monies are reimbursed to the tribe
- REPEATED FRAUD Suspension to be determined by the (insert review board, in the absence of a review board the Business Committee shall assume the responsibility). Suspension could range as far as lifetime banishment from ALL tribal programs
