17	Housing Authority Report – Ben Dixon		
18	Presented explanation that Resolution Number 061219R-03 will need		
19	to be rescinded and a new resolution will be presented in its place.		
20	This is due to confusion about the ICBDG grants and the way that they		
21	want to call the years. The first one that will be rescinded tonight is		
22	considered the 18 ICDBG and this next one is now considered the		
23	19/20. HUD is now combining one application that covers two years.		
24	The Grant has been raised to \$900,000.00 with a match of		
25	\$300,000.00 instead of the \$800,000.00 with a match of \$200,000.00.		
26 27	We were not awarded the competitive grant that was applied for, which was the approximately \$300,000,000 grant that we were going		
28	to use to build houses. We are now a CDBO so we are eligible to		
29	request those funds from HUD to build individual houses. We would		
30	only be able to build maybe 5 houses. We want to dedicate the entire		
31	grant to building houses and we will look elsewhere for funds to build		
32	roads.

- 54 Chief Wallace reports she continues to receive numerous thank

- 57 **Donation Requests One request submitted from a fund for**
- teachers, Support 2020 Alliance. This is a fund for teacher
- 59 fellowships. Donation was not approved.
- 60 Director Reports handout provided by Chief Wallace.
- **Travel Reports handout provided by Chief Wallace**
- 62 Tribal Leadership Meeting Report 34 Tribes participated with
- 63 NIGA, Ernie Stephens, Liz Homan and Jason Giles also in
- 64 attendance. 32 tribes were there physically with 2 tribes
- 65 represented by proxy. Points covered Gov. Stitt has been
- sued not the State of Oklahoma. The reason for that is that the
- 67 Compact is a Federal Law. Gov. Stitt has retained Counsel. The
- suit was filed Dec. 31, 2019 by three tribes, the Choctaw,
- 69 Chickasaw and the Cherokee. Jan. 2nd the Chickasaws received
- 70 a letter from OMES about conducting an audit. The Chickasaw
- 71 appeared in Court on Jan. 2nd and stated that since Gov. Still
- states the Compact is no longer active there would be no
- 73 reason for them to submit to an audit and they politely left.
- Jan. 6th Gov. Stitt was served in his office and that serving
- 75 triggers some litigation deadlines. Jan. 20th is the typical
- deadline date for the tribes to make their revenue payments for
- 77 the Dec. 20th gaming revenue. Jan. 27th they have to respond
- 78 to that. One of the most important dates is Feb. 20th. Stitt
- 79 maintains the compact has expired in 2019, so Feb. 20th is
- 80 when we make payments for the 20th of Jan. So the question is
- 81 whether Gov. Still will accept these payments and whether or
- 82 not he can afford to not accept them. March 20th is the last
- 83 date the state can accept or reject those funds. April 6th is the
- 84 latest date for the judge to issue a scheduling order. A date
- has been scheduled for ITC meeting over at the ITC Building for
- 36 Jan. 15th. Matt Morgan will be attending with the OIGA team

- and they are inviting the Chiefs of the 9 Tribes of Ottawa
- 88 County to be in attendance. They are encouraging everyone to
- 89 contact their Legislatures. Tribes are encouraged to file suits
- 90 as a group instead of individually.
- 91 Signage A new large sign has been put up across the street
- 92 from the Seneca Telephone Company and we are waiting for
- 93 the two additional signs providing directions to Indigo Sky to
- 94 be put up.
- 95 Summer Youth Program is for our Eastern Shawnee Tribal
- youth ages 16 and up. As there is talk about raising the
- 97 minimum wage from \$7.00 something to \$12.00 an hour. We
- 98 have decided to start our Summer Youth at a wage of \$10.40
- and will raise it .40 a year and within 5 years that would get us
- to the \$12.00 and it won't be such a huge impact on us.
- 101 Summer Intern Program is for students that have already
- graduated from high school and are either in college or intend
- 103 to go to college. This program is basically for those that are
- most interested in Science and it would be in the EPA
- 105 Department. A grant has been written for two people. That
- will come through the BIA in Miami and NEO College has
- indicated their support. Christy already has in her budget and
- in one of her grants for an intern same definition. Does not
- 109 have to be Eastern Shawnee but does have to be Native
- 110 American. So that would make two summer interns on this
- grant and one summer intern on the grant that is already in
- 112 existence. Those would start at our minimum wage which is
- 113 **\$11.37/hr.**
- 114 Relocation of Hoop Houses We are requesting to move our
- Hoop Houses up to Highway 10 property as the current place
- they are located floods when it rains. They are portable and
- can be moved. We would like to do this as quickly as possible
- as planting season is going to be here quickly.
- 119 Stateline Road Chief Wallace reports that weather permitting
- they will be paying that road next week.
- 121 Chief Wallace answered questions about David Wyrick who was
- 122 hired as a Project Director for the construction work on the
- 123 Early Childhood Development Center. She states this will
- become a constant position for him and will take a lot of
- burden off of the maintenance staff.
