- 49 **ECLC Progress Work continued on Monday on inside since**
- 50 children and workers were out for the holiday. Sheet rock is
- 50% complete on inside, AC units have been moved and
- installed, electricity hooked up, carpets have been cleaned and
- 53 the outside rock has been scheduled to be here Wednesday.
- 54 Doors and windows are being placed. Nursery has been
- 55 temporarily moved into Stacy's office. No completion date at
- this time but may be done within a month.
- 57 **EPA Report We have processed the payment out of the**
- 58 lockbox. There are four parties involved with three being alive
- 59 and one deceased and will have to go through probate. All
- 60 have been paid and all deeds have been received. All notices
- 61 have been sent to the BIA.
- In reference to the Feryl Hogs grant they have observed hogs
- on the Hwy. 60 property. Martin Bros. have agreed to allow
- 64 trapping on their property. Cameras have been installed and
- 65 traps are ready where hogs have been reported. Chief Wallace
- 66 explained how the McGirt decision could affect our Tribe.
- 67 Hip Report Amber reports that as of 5-1-18, 86 homes have
- been completed. 22 since Amber started at the end of April.

- 69 **28** remain to be completed and **15** are in progress. The
- remaining balance in the budget is \$254,078.50.
- 71 Senior Prom was held by the AOA on a Saturday afternoon. It
- 72 was an outdoor event and attendance was down. Duke Mason
- 73 was the entertainment. All reported a good time.
- 74 McGirt Supreme Court Ruling and Ramifications Joe Halloran,
- 75 an attorney from Minnesota who is involved in a lot of
- 76 Oklahoma Cases. He has submitted a proposal to tribes in
- 77 Ottawa County that they join in an AMICUS brief. The Miami
- 78 and Ottawa Tribes have committed and he has sent an inquiry
- 79 to the Wyandotte tribe to see if they want to join and he is also
- asking our tribe if we would like to participate as this will be an
- issue that we will have to face in the future. He estimates this
- 82 will take a total of 100 hours and the Grand Total Services
- would be \$19,250. If 4 join the cost would be shared at
- \$4,912.50 each, if 3 join the cost would be \$6,550 for each
- 85 party.
- **TOBACCO COMPACTS Received an email from Matthew**
- 87 Morgan, Chair of OIGA and he indicated that he has been
- 88 contacted by two tribes who have been contacted by Gov. Stitt
- 89 saying that Oklahoma will not have a Tobacco Compact with
- 90 them. He was reaching out to see if the rest of the tribes had
- 91 heard anything about this. This information has been sent to
- 92 Audrey Dixon, Tribal Attorney and our Compact does not end
- 93 until **2023**.
- 94 **SOCIAL SERVICE report provided.** As of 9-30 Chief Wallace
- points out that in Burial we are over \$23,943.76 but in
- 96 Disabled/Elder Care/Emergency there is still \$455,909.63 left
- 97 in budget. Elder Crisis Committee has \$3,295.89 left and

- 102 CDC and IHBG GRANTS have received official notification that
- we can now begin spending. CDC grant will be used to remodel

- begin to make our own sanitizers. The IHBG is to establish a
- 106 food bank, doing a couple of tiny homes and adding a food
- 107 bank to the property up on HWY 60.
- 108 Woodland Duplexes We have been advertising and have had
- 7 applications. Will be meeting to review and make selections.
- 110 THOUGHTS ABOUT THANKSGIVING BASKETS Due to Covid-19
- in order to remain healthy and safe instead of doing food
- baskets we are considering giving gift cards.
