205 governing law, mediation, arbitration, limited waiver of Woodlands' sovereign immunity, 206 consent to jurisdiction and other dispute resolution provisions (collectively, the "Dispute 207 Resolution Provisions"), as set forth in the Agreement and hereby independently, by and 208 through this Resolution, expressly and unequivocally grants such Dispute Resolution 209 Provisions set as specifically forth below (capitalized terms used in the below, but not 210 defined, will have the meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement and all section 211 references in the text below will refer to sections in the Agreement):

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION & SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY.

214 10.1. Mediation. If there is a dispute between the Parties concerning 215 the interpretation or implementation of this Agreement, then the Parties shall first 216 attempt to resolve the dispute through informal discussions. If the Parties are unable 217 to resolve the dispute through informal discussions, then the Parties shall attempt 218 to resolve the dispute through non-binding mediation. Any applicable statute of 219 limitations shall toll during informal dispute resolution discussions. Such tolling 220 period shall begin upon written notice by the Party asserting the applicable claim, 221 and end thirty (30) days after written notice from either Party that it is ending 222 informal dispute resolution discussions. If the Parties are unable to resolve the 223 dispute through non-binding mediation, then the dispute shall be resolved by 224 arbitration pursuant to Section 10.2.

225 10.2 Arbitration. Unless resolved pursuant to Section 10.1, any 226 controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or breach of this 227 Agreement shall be settled by arbitration in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The arbitration shall 228 be administered by an arbitrator that the Parties mutually agree on and in 229 accordance with the then current Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American 230 Arbitration Association, provided R-52(c) shall not apply. The language to be used 231 in the arbitration proceeding shall be English. The arbitrator may award monetary 232 damages, injunctive relief, costs, and attorney's fees. The arbitration award shall be 233 final and binding regardless of whether one of the parties fails or refuses to 234 participate in the arbitration. The arbitrator shall not have the power to amend this 235 Agreement in any respect. Any action to compel arbitration or enforce judgment on 236 the award entered by the arbitrator may be entered in the Mashantucket Pequot 237 Tribal Nation's Tribal Court or, if against Customer, in the CFR Court of Indian 238 Offences for the Eastern Oklahoma Region.

10.3 Sovereign Immunity of Wondr Nation. Wondr Nation 239 240 represents and warrants that, pursuant to Title 12, Section 3 and any other 241 applicable provision of the laws of Mashantucket, Wondr Nation has expressly 242 waived its sovereign immunity from suit by Customer for the purposes of 243 compelling arbitration or enforcing an arbitration award in accordance with Section 244 10.2, that such waiver is valid, legal, and binding without any further action from 245 Wondr Nation or the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation, and that pursuant to 246 Article VIII, Section 7 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Mashantucket 247 Pequot Tribal Nation such waiver cannot be revoked.

250 10.4 Sovereign Immunity of Customer. This Agreement does not 251 waive or otherwise affect Customer's sovereign immunity from suit, except as 252 expressly and specifically provided in this Section 10.4. Customer grants Wondr 253 Nation, and no other party, a limited waiver of its sovereign immunity from suit 254 exclusively for the purposes of compelling arbitration or enforcing an arbitration 255 award before the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation's Tribal Court or the CFR 256 Court of Indian Offences for the Eastern Oklahoma Region in accordance with 257 Section 10.2. Customer does not grant Wondr Nation a waiver of its sovereign 258 immunity from suit for any other purpose or remedy. This limited waiver of 259 sovereign immunity shall not extend to, is not for the benefit of, and is not 260 enforceable by any third party or assignee of Wondr Nation. An arbitration award 261 shall not be enforceable against Customer pursuant to this limited waiver of 262 sovereign immunity unless such award is subject to the limitations on types and 263 amounts of damages set forth in Section 8 of this Agreement. Further, an arbitration 264 award shall only be enforceable against Customer pursuant to this limited waiver 265 of sovereign immunity if it affects the assets of Customer only. An arbitration 266 award which purports to affect any other assets of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of 267 Oklahoma shall not be enforceable against Customer. Customer's limited waiver 268 of sovereign immunity shall be of limited duration, applying only during the term 269 of this Agreement and for twelve (12) months thereafter. Customer's limited waiver 270 of sovereign immunity shall not apply to any claim that does not strictly comply 271 with this Section 10.4. Nothing in this Agreement waives, modifies, or affects the 272 sovereign immunity of the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma. . . .

11.3 Governing Law. This Agreement shall be construed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with and shall be governed by the laws of Mashantucket applicable to agreements entered into and to be wholly performed therein.

278 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Business Committee of the Eastern Shawnee 279 Tribe of Oklahoma hereby determines that the limited waiver of sovereign immunity set 280 forth above and the other Dispute Resolution Provisions, subject to the authorization 281 contained herein, conform in all respects to and meet the requirements of the laws of the 282 Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma.

283

284 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Committee of the Eastern Shawnee 285 Tribe of Oklahoma hereby authorizes the Chair of the Woodlands Management's Board of 286 Directors, or his or designee, to execute the Agreement.

287

288 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, except as expressly and specifically set forth in this 289 Resolution, the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma, Woodlands, and Woodlands 290 Management do not waive, alter, or otherwise diminish their sovereign immunity from suit. 291

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Agreement may be signed in one or more 292 293 counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which shall constitute

one instrument and a facsimile signature or electronically scanned copy of a signature shall constitute and shall be deemed to be sufficient evidence of a party's execution of this consent, without necessity of further proof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon the execution and delivery of the Agreement together with any amendments or modifications thereto and other instruments or other documents delivered in connection with the Agreement, they shall be the valid and binding obligations of Woodlands enforceable in accordance with their respective terms.
